NOTE:

Remarks about the 'Format' column:

- LP: It mains "Long Play". I use it to refer to a conventional album, with a length between 35-75 minutes. The usual length is around 40-60 minutes.
- EP: It mains "Extended Play". I use it to refer to a conventional mini-LP. So, the length usually is between 15-25 minutes. Most of the times all the tracks are unreleased music at the release date, not related to previous recordings.
- Single: A very short release, around 5-10 minutes of music most of the times. Usually one or two tracks (in conventional lengths). Unlike the EP, the music can be related to previous recordings, not necessarily unreleased.
- Compilation: A collection of tracks from previous releases, maybe with some unreleased music (but not much). Length around 40-75 minutes (similar to a LP).
- Demo: Demo versions preparing a future release. Short length and not conventional in my music (except for the first recordings of my metal project CAUTIVA (around 2006-2008), I have never recorded demos; I record directly the final tracks).
- 2-LP, 3-LP, 4-LP...: It means twice, three times, four times... the length of a conventional LP. 2-LP is usually around 2 hours of music, 3-LP is around 3 hours, and so on. We can understand the number as number of discs too... On the other hand, I also use it for a compilation release. For example, "2-LP Compilation" means a compilation of 2 discs (around 2 hours of music).

The composition based on «sporadic music» is a very creative, intuitive and unpredictable work, making rules, use them and later break them at all to do and mix new rules and so on The result is minimalist and reiterative, expressionist and unstable, surrealist sometimes, always interesting Since then, I have never returned so hard to this style of composition, but anyway has been a recurring element in my music, because we can find it in later pieces such as: «Las Cinco Construcciones de Babel» (2000), «Jazz en Clave Mínimo-Andalusí» (2002), «The Great Old One» (2009, Cautiva project) or «Ramifications Dans L'Escalier Du Diable» (2011, György Ligeti cover).
ADDITIONAL NOTES:	 This EP was originally released -with «Lluvia de Mayo» (CD-S, 2000)- as a promo preview of an upcoming album to be released in summer of 2000 and called «Tres Piezas de Tres» (translated as "Three Pieces of Three"; these three music sporadic essays, three romantic poems and the piece in three movements «Orgía Tonal en Partitura de Cristal»). Finally this album was never released. Don't ask why! Cover artwork by Sara Valiente. Sleeve design is mine. This EP was re-mastered in September of 2008.

DESCRIPTION:	 EP collecting three recordings for piano revising very different styles. The track #1, written in 2002 and recorded live in the studio, is an experimental-fusion piece in which I try to reunite a collage of four styles of music: jazz, minimalism, flamenco and "sporadic music" (go to the <u>«Ensayos sobre Música Esporádica»</u> EP to know more about my old style of composition called "sporadic music"). <i>«Raymond Blue»</i>, the track #2, is a piece of romantic style constructed with different improvisations recorded during the last

	 days of December of 2000. As curiosity, a brief fragment of one of the passages is directly connected (a tribute) to <i>«The Fosse»</i>, piece for piano and voice written by Wim Mertens for the <i>«Maximizing The Audience»</i> album of 1985. <i>«Raymond Blue»</i> was my <i>«Romantic Poem No. 3»</i>. Finally, the track #3 -written in March of 2000- is dedicated to the minimalist composer Steve Reich. Written for two pianos, all the music of this piece is built from a single musical motif made with complex chords along 18 steps of one only bar. Into a hyper-organized and rigid structure, this motif always appears in four forms (slow, fast, slow and retrograde, fast and retrograde), playing a piano a higher octave than the other and both suffering acceleration and deceleration by steps, and following a time routine, until to reach again the same beginning of the motif. This collapse creates unimaginable things! :-)

	 This EP/demo has four songs. I composed two of the songs; the other two tunes are cover songs (Megadeth and Coroner). Some interesting ideas, but not a polished work. Just a step to reach the album <i>«Human»</i> (2009).
ADDITIONAL NOTES:	 Sleeve design is mine. I consider this recording more a demo than a real EP, but it was originally released in 2008 under this format (EP). I wasn't happy with the production or my vocals. Anyway, it wasn't a serious recording, and a very very bad and limited equipment was used. Additionally, my skills as singer or sound technician were really awful then! Some of the vocals are taken from the previous demo of 2007, in which you can find early versions of the tracks #2 and #3. The track «Fire, Walk With Me!» was remastered in 2020 in a slightly more extended version.

DESCRIPTION:	 This is my second recording under the pseudonym of <i>Cautiva</i>, a technical and progressive thrash metal project in which I play all the instruments (guitars, bass, drums programming and vocals; except for guest musicians in very limited cases), in the style of "one man's band". This album makes part of the mistakes found in <i>«Fire, Walk With Me!»</i> (EP/demo, 2008) –poor production and still a poor technology to record correctly this style of music in-the-box–, but it's one of the recordings of which I'm proudest. While the previous EP did not show a clearly defined style, this album shows an evident direction, musical and lyrically. This direction is very specific: technical and progressive thrash metal, with a lot of aggressiveness. On the other hand, I think the music is rather good, and I enjoyed a lot recording this. I felt inspired since the first minute and everything flowed very well. It was a great experience in my memory.
ADDITIONAL NOTES:	 This album was very well received by the tech/prog thrash metal community. It was nice :-) I make some tributes in this album: The beginning of the track #7 is a tribute to Chuck Schuldiner and the band Death, making a variation on the opening of the song «Spirit Crusher» (1998). This same track, #7, has 8 guitar solos at the end. Here I make a tribute to Muhammed Suiçmez and the band Necrophagist (solos #1, final of #3, and #5 are taken from this band). The rest of the solos are mine. Track #8 is a Testament cover (1988), but the end of this track is the beginning of the song «Bonded By Blood» by Exodus (1983). Disc #2 (Water) is dedicated to my experimental and avant-garde music, changing music as the states of the water Disc #3 (Fire) is dedicated to my technical, progressive and extreme thrash metal project CAUTIVA. Finally, disc #4 (Air) is dedicated to the electronic music that I was creating during the last years, in which wind and air play an important role. All the tracks (except #209 and #309) are remastered here from their original releases. Except for the disc #3, all the remaster work was made between May and November of 2022. The disc #3 (Cautiva stuff) was remastered previously.
